II. Discussion

A copy of another schools student council aims were reviewed and after some clarification of what some of the phrases meant all the council agreed that these should become the aims of the student council at The Brades Lodge

The council were asked what they thought the school uniform should be and they all agreed that they liked the polo shirts, either blue or white.

We discussed the point of the logo and everyone agreed that it is important as it identifies the students as part of the school. Ideally all students should have the logo visible during the day but it is not essential that the polo shirts the students wear have the logo.

On the subject of footwear we discussed the idea of all black footwear also including trainers. They must be completely black including the logos. Kamarlee demonstrated what this might look like with his black trainers.

The council looked at the new school logo which Mr Toplass had mocked up in purple and gold. After much discussion around the fact that it didn't mention the Brades Lodge and confirmation that it will they approved.

III. Outcomes

A copy of the Aims will be typed up and put around the school and on the website as soon as possible

The uniforms that were being worn around the table were all approved as most had the logo visible. Kamarlee was wearing a plain white polo shirt which was also approved on the assumption that and jumper he wore would be sporting the school name.

The council will draft a letter to go out to the students explaining the shift in thought regarding plain black footwear. They will hand this draft to Mrs. Warner who will type it up and all members of the council will sign it before it gets handed to the students, they hope to get this letter approved at the next council meeting. The letter will contain pictures of approved footwear and some of those that would not be approved.

The council agreed that internal exclusion should be used as a sanction for non-compliance of the uniform code as sending students home might mean that they do not come back.

The new school logo was approved as they liked the idea of it being on a sports strip!
